United Nations Educational, Science and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) hereby invite qualified companies to submit sealed tenders as follows:

The Assignment:

The assignment is to undertake a summative evaluation of the Advanced Regional Training Programme in Education for Sustainable Development (ESD) for ECCE, Primary and TVET Teacher Educators in Southern Africa - 'Sustainability Starts with Teachers'. The programme has been implemented in eleven countries in the Southern African Development Community (SADC) with the financial support of the Swedish International Cooperation Agency (Sida) from 2018 to 2022. The evaluation shall be conducted by a team of independent external experts between February and June 2022 in line with the UNESCO Evaluation Policy.

Expected Outputs:

- (i) inception report;
- (ii) draft evaluation report; and
- (iii) final evaluation report together with communication outputs to be agreed upon in the inception phase.

Required Qualifications:

- An advanced university degree in one or more fields related to this evaluation;
- At least 10 years of professional experience in project and/or programme evaluation, planning and management in one or more fields related to this evaluation;
- At least ten years of work experience in evaluation and one or more fields related to ESD acquired at the international level or in an international setting including at least three years acquired in Southern Africa;
- Knowledge of and experience in applying qualitative and quantitative data analysis techniques and RBM principles;
- Experience in conducting cross-country evaluation and reporting;
- Excellent oral communication and writing skills in English;
- Excellent analytical skills and skills in producing succinct, clear materials;
- No previous involvement in the design and /or implementation of activities under review.
